

International Solar Expo and Conference 2024 (ISE 2024) Theme: Innovating for a Sustainable Future

Guidelines for participation of Academia

- The Universities may participate in the Expo through:
 - O <u>Keynote speeches</u>: About 3 Faculty members will be nominated by the respective HODs, including names, positions and title of presentation; and the list will be finalized in consultation with the ISE-2024 Academia Coordinators and published on the website and in the Proceedings-ISE-2024.
 - o <u>Ideas Competition:</u> About 5 Undergraduate Candidates will be selected by HODS and finalized in consultation with Academia Coordinators. They will share concepts of their final year products through the model developed and displayed at the stalls provided by the organizers. Names of the Candidates/Projects will be published on the website and in the Proceedings-ISE-2024.
 - o <u>Posters Competition:</u> Postgraduate scholars will share abstracts of their thesis/research results as a solution to resolve the current issues faced by the solar industry. The abstracts will be peer reviewed and published as "Proceedings of the First International Solar Expo and Conference 2024", jointly by GreenWend Energy Private Ltd and University of Engineering and Technology, Peshawar. Format given below.
 - o Shields/Certificates will be awarded to the keynote speakers.
 - o Certificates will be awarded to all participants of the competition and shields will be given to winners.
 - o Cash prizes will also be given to top 3 competitors in the following order: i) Ist: 50,000; 2nd: 30,000; 3rd: 15,000
- The deadline for poster and idea submission will be 15th April, 2024.
- The basis for the idea will be: "what SDG based business solutions the students can come up with keeping in mind their past research and academic learning"?
- A committee of judges will evaluate the submission for acceptance.
- Vice Chancellors of the respective Universities will be requested to record a short video message expressing their thoughts about ISE and the Sunsavior products.

Preparation of Abstract for posters competition

Use Calibri fonts, size 11 with a maximum word count of 300, comprising the following components:

- **Title** (Comprehensive and precise, describing your study)
- Names: Names of authors and affiliated institutions; email id of the corresponding author
- Background (Why is your work important? Does it fill any gaps in knowledge or research?)
- Purpose (What are the objectives? You may include a short statement of your hypothesis.)
- Method (Explain your methods, such as study design. What was done, by whom, how and where? What measurements were taken and how were the data managed?)
- **Results** (What did you find, discover or achieve? Not just in subjective terms, but also in the form of data. How significant were your findings?)
- **Conclusion** (What were your overall findings? What is your scope for integration into solar industry practices? What are the suggestions for future work?)
- **Poster preparation:** Size: 36" x 48", Orientation: Landscape, better to use powerpoint for inserting boxes, figures and text; after preparation, the soft copy may be communicated to the Academia Coordinators mentioned on the first page. The panaflex printout may be communicated to the Coordinators up to 30 April, 2024.
